STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Method of Payment of Alimony.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 153, § 63, amended. The 1st sentence of section 63 of chapter 153 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Pending a petition to enforce a decree of alimony, or a decree for payment of money instead thereof, or for the support of minor children, or a decree for support pending libel, or for the payment of counsel fees, the court may order the husband or father to pay to the elerk of the court wife or mother, or to counsel for the wife or mother sufficient money for the prosecution thereof, upon default of which order execution may issue as in actions of tort.'
