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**AN ACT Relating to Divorce.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 153, §§ 64-A, 64-B, additional.** Chapter 153 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto 2 new sections to be numbered 64-A and 64-B, to read as follows:

**'Sec. 64-A. Parties divorced shall not remarry within 1 year. Neither party to a divorce action shall remarry until the expiration of 1 year from the date of the signing of the decree granting a divorce.**

**Sec. 64-B. Penalty if persons remarry within 1 year. Anyone who shall remarry within 1 year after the granting of a decree of divorce shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than 1 year, or by both such fine and imprisonment.'**
