STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relative to the Salary of the Recorder of the Yorkshire Municipal Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1911, c. 279, § 15, amended. Section 15 of chapter 279 of the private and special laws of 1911, as amended by chapter 30 of the private and special laws of 1935, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 15. Salary of judge. The judge shall receive a salary in full for all services of \$1000 per annum to be paid him by the county of York, and the recorder a salary of \$500 \$800 per annum, payable quarterly.'
