**AN ACT Relating to License for the Taking of Sea Moss for Commercial
Purposes.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 147, repealed and replaced. Section 147 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Sec. 147. Taking of sea moss. No person shall take sea moss for commercial purposes from any of the shores or from any coastal waters of the state until he has procured from the commissioner a license therefor. The license shall be issued to a resident upon payment of a fee of \$1.

Any non-resident of the state may procure a commercial sea moss license upon payment of a fee of \$5.'
