IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Sale of Hatcheries and Feeding Station Property Authorized.

Sale of hatcheries and feeding station property authorized. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game is hereby authorized to sell any hatchery or feeding station property which is no longer needed in the operation of the fish and game department. All sales shall be approved by the governor and council and the moneys received from such sales shall be paid into a fund to be used for the construction of new hatcheries or feeding stations at more suitable locations.
