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**AN ACT Relating to Education of Physically Handicapped Children.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 37, § 180-I, repealed and replaced.** Section 180-I of chapter 37 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 149 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

**'Sec. 180-I. Appropriation. In addition to appropriations from the general fund of the state, funds from other sources may be accepted by the department, subject to the approval of the governor and council, and expended to carry out the provisions of sections 180-A to 180-H, inclusive.'**
