#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in favor of George E. Leatherbarrow, of Saco.

Teacher's pension granted to George E. Leatherbarrow. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid out of the appropriation for teachers' pensions, to George E. Leatherbarrow of Saco, in the county of York, the sum of \$600 per year, during the lifetime of said Leatherbarrow, the sum to be paid in quarterly installments.

George E. Leatherbarrow has been a teacher for 40 years, the last 30 years of which have been spent at Thornton Academy.
