STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of Stacyville Plantation.

Stacyville Plantation; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$1,718.87 be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of Stacyville Plantation to reimburse the said plantation for money due it for the years 1924 through 1944, inclusive, under the provisions of subsection III of section 9 of chapter 173 of the public laws of 1921, as amended, said sum to be paid from the appropriation of the department of education.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

STACYVILLE PLANTATION

January 30, 1947

Kelley Hill School closed—July, 1922.

In 1946 it was discovered that although the above school was closed in 1922, the school was never reported to the Department of Education as a closed school, except in the 1946 report for which the Plantation of Stacyville was reimbursed through the school fund. Therefore, the plantation submits the following costs incurred yearly for conveyance of the pupils who would have attended the Kelley Hill school. These figures were furnished to the plantation by Mr. Ernest G. Tupper, Superintendent of Schools.
