STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Height and Width of Motor Vehicles and Trailers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 19, § 85, amended. The 1st sentence of section 85 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'No motor vehicle or trailer which, with or without load, is wider than 8 feet or, in the case of passenger busses 102 inches, over all, or is over 12 feet, 6 inches high, shall be operated upon any way or bridge.'
