AN ACT Relating to "Daylight Saving Time".

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 1, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 1 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Sec. 4. Standard time defined; "daylight saving time". Within this state the standard time shall be that which is known and designated by the federal statute as "United States Eastern Standard Time." **"Daylight Saving Time"**, adopted by any municipality, shall be such time which is 1 hour faster than the "United States Eastern Standard Time." Any municipality adopting said daylight saving time shall adhere to the dates May 15th to October 15th, annually, in order to make such time uniform throughout the state.'
