IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Changing the Definition of a Restaurant for Liquor License Purposes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 1, amended. The 13th paragraph of section 1 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Restaurant" shall mean a reputable place operated by responsible persons of good reputation and habitually and regularly used for the purpose of providing food for the public, and provided with adequate and sanitary kitchen and dining-room equipment and capacity for preparing and serving suitable food for the public. Proper food must be available to the public during the morning, noon and evening and sales must reflect a bona fide restaurant business."
