STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Van Buren for a Secondary School Building.

Town of Van Buren; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated in favor of the town of Van Buren the sum of \$50,000 from the general fund of the state for the purpose of constructing a secondary school building.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The school buildings in Van Buren have been destroyed by fire. Due to this loss, classrooms are overcrowded to the extent that the education of the children of Van Buren and vicinity is seriously hampered. It is impossible under present conditions to present the proper educational curriculum that is required by the department of education.
