**RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Hebron for Tuition Paid for
Ronald Bishop.**

Town of Hebron; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$125 from the general fund of the state to be paid to the town of Hebron to reimburse said town for tuition paid for Ronald Bishop, a state pauper.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Ronald Bishop, a state pauper being boarded, by the state's Division of Poor Relief, in the town of Hebron, attended Paris High School during the 1945-46 school year. The town of Hebron paid the tuition of \$125 and asks that the state reimburse it in the amount of \$125. Receipted bills are on file.
