**RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Strong for Money Expended for  
State Paupers.**

---

**Town of Strong; reimbursed. Resolved:** That the sum of \$178.19 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of Strong, to reimburse said town for aid rendered to Walter McDonald, Angie Farmer and Fred Harmon, state paupers; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Aid to the 3 above-named state paupers was rendered by the town of Strong in the years 1941, 1942 and 1943, in amounts as follows:

Walter McDonald	\$ 61.50
Angie Farmer	44.29
Fred Harmon	72.40

\$178.19

The cases were not cleared through the Department of Health and Welfare, due to neglect of former town official, and the 3 persons given aid were all residents of Freeman Township at the time aid was given.
