RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Greenwood Pond in Elliotsville Plantation, Piscataquis County.

Ice fishing in Elliotsville plantation, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Greenwood pond in Elliotsville plantation, Piscataquis county, to ice fishing.
