**RESOLVE, Closing Monson Pond Stream in Piscataquis County to All
Fishing.**

Monson Pond stream closed to fishing. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to close Monson Pond stream, sometimes known as Barber brook, in Piscataquis county, to all fishing for all seasons.
