## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Measurement of Herring.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 34, § 26, amended. The 1st paragraph of section 26 of chapter 34 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by repealing the last sentence thereof and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Such measurement of quantity shall be made and established at the time of purchase of such herring. All boats used to carry herring so purchased shall be officially measured by the state sealer of weights and measures and permanent markers placed in the hold of all such boats showing measurement of quantity of herring deposited in the hold of all such boats, with a clear marker at points in the hold designating deposit of each 25 bushels of such herring.'
