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**RESOLVE, in Favor of Frederick B. Battle, Jr., of Rhode Island.**

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**Frederick B. Battle, Jr.; compensated. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$115.73 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Frederick B. Battle, Jr., of Rhode Island, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his car by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This accident occurred on June 8, 1946, in Standish, and was investigated by Game Warden George Townsend. Mr. Battle's car was damaged as follows: Radiator grill pushed in, radiator has hole in it; fan shaft bent, fan broken, left headlight broken, left fender split, left side of hood crushed. The car had to be towed 6 miles. Mr. Battle is from Quanset Point, Rhode Island.
