RESOLVE, in Favor of Lemuel Morrell, of Limestone.

Lemuel Morrell; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$372.27 from the general fund of the state to be paid to Lemuel Morrell, of Limestone, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his truck by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Morrell's truck, driven by Harold Morrell, was damaged considerably, on October 17, 1946, in the town of Princeton, and was investigated by game warden Harland Hitchings. The damage is as follows: Left fender and headlight destroyed; front grill bent in and broken; radiator broken enough to leak; right sealed beam broken and parking light; right front fender bent, but repairable; broken left spring; bent front axle; ruined the front steering arms; left front wheel off, ruined everything on that wheel, ruined right front spring.
