## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT Relating to Business Hours in State Liquor Stores.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 57, § 10, amended. Section 10 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 10. Business hours for state stores. State stores shall not be open on Sundays, court holidays, or on the day of the holding of a general election or state-wide primary or between the hours of 8 P. M. and 9 A. M., except that in municipalities operating on daylight saving time, state liquor stores may be opened at 8 A. M., standard time, and also except on Saturdays when, if open, they may be kept open until 10 P. M., and the commission is authorized to regulate the opening and closing hours of each store within the provisions of this chapter. No sales shall be made therein to minors, or persons under the influence of liquor.'
