AN ACT Assessing a Poll-Tax on Females.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 81, § 1, amended. The 1st sentence of section 1 of chapter 81 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'A poll-tax shall be assessed upon every male **and female** inhabitant of the state above the age of 21 years whether a citizen of the United States or an alien, in the manner provided by law, unless he is exempted therefrom by the provisions of this chapter, which said poll-tax shall be \$3.'
