STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Permitting Bowling on Sunday.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 121, § 39, amended. Section 39 of chapter 121 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:
- '; or to the operation of bowling alleys, or to bowling therein from 2 P. M. to 11 P. M.'
- Sec. 2. P. L., 1943, c. 292, repealed. Chapter 292 of the public laws of 1943 is hereby repealed.
