STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to State Owned Cars.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 29-A, additional. Chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 29-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 29-A. State owned cars available to state employees. State owned cars shall be made available to state employees, who are required to travel by automobile to carry out their various responsibilities, for business purposes only. State owned cars shall be provided such workers at the request of the department head, approved by the governor and council, in whose department such employees work and shall be provided for such length of time as the department head shall recommend. The state purchasing agent shall arrange for care and maintenance of such state cars in a place convenient and accessible to the employee or employees to whom the car is assigned.'
