STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, in Favor of E. Earle Harvey of So. Portland.

E. Earle Harvey; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$110.50 from the general fund of the state to be paid to E. Earle Harvey, of So. Portland, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the state for damage to his truck by a deer.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

On July 11, 1946, in the town of Alfred, a deer jumped in front of the Ford truck owned by E. Earle Harvey and driven by Norman A. Harvey, causing damage to the following extent: Radiator broken and perhaps beyond repair; radiator grill badly damaged; dent in front right fender; right front headlight damaged. Game Warden Henry H. Gross investigated the accident.
