RESOLVE, in Favor of Joseph V. Tardiff, of Augusta.

Joseph V. Tardiff; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$2,000 to be paid to Joseph V. Tardiff, of Augusta, to compensate him in full for all claims against the state for injuries sustained by him during his employment with the state department of health and welfare; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the state.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Tardiff was a passenger in a car operated by another state employee who has already been compensated by the legislature for damages and injuries.
