RESOLVE, in Favor of W. E. & E. E. Andrews, of Bingham.

W. E. & E. E. Andrews; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$3500 from the general highway fund to be paid to W. E. & E. E. Andrews, of Bingham, as a full and final settlement for their claim against the state for damage done on Austin stream by the highway commission in 1940.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Work done by the highway commission changed the course of the Austin stream so that the mill lot was greatly damaged. The work was done over protest of Mr. Andrews.
