AN ACT Relating to Trapping of Muskrats.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 97, amended. Section 97 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding after the 7th paragraph thereof a new paragraph to read as follows:

'There shall be an open season on muskrats from November 1st to January 31st, both inclusive; provided, however, that it shall be illegal to trap or set traps for muskrats after November 30th within 200 feet of any beaver dam, beaver den or house; or in or at the flowage of any waters inhabited by beaver when such waters are not open to beaver trapping.'
