AN ACT Relating to Superintendence of Schools Through Union Towns.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 68, amended. The 2nd, 3rd and 4th sentences of section 68 of chapter 37 of the revised statutes are hereby repealed and the following sentence enacted in place thereof:

'No present existing supervisory school union as of June 30, 1946 shall be changed without the approval of the superintending school committee of a majority of the towns comprising that supervisory school union.'
