Providing for a fish screen at outlet of Kewayden lake in the town of Stoneham in the county of Oxford. Resolved: That the sum of \$800 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the legislative appropriation for the department of inland fisheries and game, for installing a fish screen at the outlet of Kewayden lake in the town of Stoneham in the county of Oxford.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This lake has been stocked with a large quantity of salmon and due to the lack of a screen at the outlet, most of these salmon escape down stream.
