# AN ACT Relating to the Responsibility of Licensees in Illegal Sales of Liquor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 57, § 66, amended.** Section 66 of chapter 57 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto 2 new paragraphs, to read as follows:

'All persons licensed under the provisions of this chapter shall themselves be held responsible criminally for the sales made by their clerks, servants or agents contrary to the provisions of this chapter while on licensed premises, whether or not the licensee was present or knew of such illegal sales.

Any sale or service by a licensee, his clerk, servant or agent on licensed premises to a customer on an order in terms commonly used to designate malt, spirituous or vinous liquor shall be conclusively presumed to be a sale or service of liquor within the meaning of this chapter.'
