STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Trespasses on Public Reserved Lots.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 32, § 46, amended. Section 46 of chapter 32 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'The assessors in the organized plantations of the state shall help police the said reserved public lots within the boundaries of their respective plantations, without any expense to the forest commissioner. Any trespasses will immediately be reported to the forest commissioner in writing.'
