IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Certain Fees of State Police Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 2, amended. The 4th sentence of section 2 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Such fees shall be taxed on a bill of costs and shall accrue to the ~~treasurer~~
~~of state county where the prosecution takes place.~~’
