STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Eligibility of Certain Veterans for Assistance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 300-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 300-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 300-A. Eligibility for assistance under other laws. Any applicant for, or recipient of assistance under the provisions of sections 299 to 306, inclusive, who is found eligible to receive public assistance under any state law for which federal funds are available, shall receive assistance under one of the state laws for which federal funds are available, provided, that aid may be granted under the provisions of sections 299 to 306, inclusive, until payments can be made under one of the state laws for which federal funds are available.'
