**AN ACT Relating to Fees for Licenses for Recreational Camps and
Roadside Places.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 154, amended. Section 154 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 154. Department authorized to license; terms and fees. The department is empowered to license eating and lodging places, recreational and overnight camps. Such licenses shall be issued by the department under such terms and conditions as it deems advisable, and fees for licenses not exceeding ~~\$5~~ \$10 may be charged. The fees thus received shall constitute a permanent fund to carry out the provisions of sections 152 to 158, inclusive.'
