IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Fees for Probate of Wills and Administrations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

R. S., c. 140, § 40-A, amended. Section 40-A of chapter 140 of the revised statutes, as enacted by chapter 359 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby amended to read as follows :

'Sec. 40-A. Fees for petitions for probate of wills and administrations. The register of probate shall receive a filing fee of \$3 for each petition to probate a will and for each petition for the administration of an estate, when the ~~estimated~~ **inventory** value of such estate, as stated in the petition, is \$1,000 or over.'
