RESOLVE, Providing for Fire Protection at the Augusta State Hospital.

Fire alarm; appropriation for. Resolved: That the sum of \$27,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund for the installation of a modern fire alarm signalling system in the Augusta state hospital.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The superintendent reports the present fire alarm system inadequate and considers the situation one that demands relief. A survey has been made by competent engineers who have furnished the above estimate for the installation of a complete, modern fire alarm system throughout the hospital.
