AN ACT Relating to Refunds of Gasoline Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 14, § 160, amended. Section 160 of chapter 14 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

“; and provided, further, that the 1c of the tax so paid on fuel used in motor boats which is not refunded under the provisions of section 166, shall be paid to the treasurer of state, to be made available to the commissioner of sea and shore fisheries for the purpose of conducting research, development and propagation activities by that department.

It is the responsibility of said commissioner to select activities and projects that will be most beneficial to the commercial fisheries of the state.’
