STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Three-Year Operators' Licenses.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 19, § 48, amended. The 1st sentence of section 48 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Applications to operate motor vehicles shall be presented by mail or otherwise to the secretary of state upon blanks prepared under his authority, and which shall therein call for specific answers to questions of a character designed to show the experience and competency of the applicant to operate a motor vehicle; a fee of \$2 \$6 shall accompany the application.'
- Sec. 2. R. S., c. 19, § 48, amended. The last paragraph of section 48 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed and the following paragraph enacted in place thereof:

'The licenses granted under the provisions of this section shall expire 3 years from date of issuance.'

Sec. 3. R. S., c. 19, § 49, repealed. Section 49 of chapter 19 of the revised statutes is hereby repealed.
