STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Increase the Salary of the County Attorney and Assistant County Attorney in Penobscot County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 130, amended. That part of section 130 of chapter 79 of the revised statutes, which relates to the salary of the county attorney and assistant county attorney of Penobscot county, as amended by section 1 of chapter 202 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'Penobscot, \$2,100 \$2,500; assistant county attorney, \$1,200 \$1,500,'
