AN ACT Relating to State Sealer of Weights and Measures.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 27, § 245, amended. Section 245 of chapter 27 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof 2 new sentences, to read as follows:

'The state sealer or his duly appointed deputy is hereby authorized to purchase, maintain and use a 100 gallon portable test measure for the testing of various gasoline and fuel oil measuring devices. The expense of purchasing this 100 gallon portable test measure shall be provided for by proceeds from the tax on gasoline as provided in section 160 of chapter 14.'
