STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Old Town Game Preserve.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 33, § 128, amended. That part of section 128 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, which relates to the Game Preserve in the city of Old Town in the county of Penobscot, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Old Town Game Preserve: The following described territory situated in the city of Old Town, in the county of Penobscot; bounded by Gilman Falls avenue on the north, Veazie street on the east Stillwater avenue on the south, and Stillwater branch of and Penobscot river on the west, north and east.'
