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### AN ACT Relating to Use of Motor-Boats in Merrymeeting Bay.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 33, § 80, amended.** Section 80 of chapter 33 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto 2 new paragraphs to read as follows:

'No motor boat of any type, either inboard or outboard, or any type of floating craft or device using a motor for propulsion, shall be operated in the waters of Merrymeeting Bay as heretofore described in the second paragraph of this section, between the hours of 12:01 A.M. and 10:00 A.M. each day during the legal open shooting season for waterfowl in said waters.

The provisions of the preceding paragraph shall not apply to any craft not equipped for hunting, or not transporting any person intending to hunt, or not transporting any material intended for use in hunting, from passing through these aforesaid waters by following the regular channel used for navigation.'
