RESOLVE, Authorizing the State Tax Assessor to Convey Certain Interest of the State in a Building on Land in Washington County to Fred O. Foster, of Forest City.

State tax assessor authorized to convey certain building. Resolved: That the state tax assessor be, and hereby is, authorized to convey to Fred O. Foster, of Forest City, whatever interest the state has in a building located on one of two settlers' lots in N. W. part, bounded W. by highway; N. by highway and Guy Lydic, Harry E. Brooks and Alton Pray land; E. by Guy Lydic and Alton Pray land; S. by George H. Oliver land, in T. 9, R. 4, N. B. P. P., Washington county, containing I acre more or less, for the sum of \$5.
