AN ACT Relating to Reissuance of State Highway Bonds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1945, c. 134, § 2, amended. Section 2 of chapter 134 of the private and special laws of 1945 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 2. Treasurer of state to issue bonds. The treasurer of state is hereby authorized under the direction of the governor and council to reissue bonds from time to time during the biennium ending June 30, 1947 and the biennium ending June 30, 1949, the said bonds not to exceed the amount of \$3,453,000, for the purpose of raising funds to match federal aid funds for the construction of state highways and bridges.'

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1945, c. 134, § 3, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 3 of chapter 134 of the private and special laws of 1945 is hereby amended to read as follows:

'None of these bonds shall mature before ~~1950~~ 1952.'
