**AN ACT Relating to the Salary of the Police Matron of the City of
Lewiston.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XI, § 11, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 11 of article XI of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The salary of said police matron shall be fixed at ~~\$1,400~~ \$2,200 per annum payable in equal weekly installments by the city treasurer.'
