STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to the Fire Department of the City of Lewiston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. XII, § 2, amended. Section 2 of article XII of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939 is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 2. Fire department, how constituted. The affairs of the fire department shall be administered by a fire commission of \mathfrak{F} 5 members to be appointed by the mayor for a term of \mathfrak{F} 5 years or until their successors have been appointed and qualified; save that at the time of appointing the first commission under this charter, the mayor shall designate the member whose term shall expire at the expiration of each period of \mathfrak{F} years 1 year for \mathfrak{F} 5 years thereafter. Vacancies occurring in the commission shall be filled by appointment by the mayor for the unexpired term provided that if no appointment be made for the period of 1 month after the vacancy shall occur, it shall be filled by the remaining members of the commission.'
