STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Licensing of Institutions, Agencies and Boarding Homes.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 4, amended. The second paragraph of section 4 of chapter 22 of the revised statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 195 of the public laws of 1945, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The term "boarding house or home" as used in this section shall mean a house or other place maintained by any association, organization or individual partly or wholly for the purpose of boarding and caring for any of the persons enumerated in the first paragraph of this section but shall not include homes licensed under the provisions of sections 243 and 244 of this chapter.'
