IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Sunday Roller Skating.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 121, §41, amended. Section 41 of chapter 121 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following new paragraph:

‘In any such city or town that shall vote therefor, and subject to the same conditions precedent and subsequent, and the same limitations, as herein contained, in respect to conducting Sunday moving picture exhibitions, it shall be lawful for any bona fide amusement park established for at least 2 years, to have roller skating on Sunday between the hours of 3 P. M. and 11:30 P. M., provided such parks are located outside the built-up section of any such city or town.’
