AN ACT Authorizing Portland University to Confer Degrees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Authorized to confer degree. Portland University, a corporation located in Portland in the county of Cumberland, shall have power and authority to confer the degree of bachelor of laws upon all persons who shall, having had not less than 2 years of college training, have completed satisfactorily at least a 3 years' course in law in said school.
