STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Use of Photostatic Copies of Wills in the Taking of Depositions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 141, § 6, amended. Section 6 of chapter 141 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following:

'In the taking of such depositions the original will shall remain in the custody of the probate court having jurisdiction thereof and a photostatic copy of said will, attested by the register of said court shall be used in the taking of such deposition with the same effect as though the original testament was so used.'
